WORD *on* FAITH

By now you may have figured out I am odd, but what I have been thinking about recently might strike you as beyond weird. The notion that we humans develop morally is not new, but I have found myself tying that idea to the Trinity.

When I was a child, like St. Paul, “I thought like a child.” Lawrence Kolberg would say my moral reasoning was pre-conventional—focused on myself, I lacked the ability to see things from other points of view. At this stage, the metaphor of God as a father allowed me to begin to distinguish between behavior that was “good” or “bad.” I needed an adult guide, such as a father, during this morally immature period.

Eventually I believe I moved beyond childish self-absorption to a stage where I was aware of others and was able to respond with empathy and compassion. Moral choices became more complex as I took to heart Jesus’ word about loving others as I loved myself. From a Christian perspective, this might be called a Christ-like stage in moral evolution, the stage at which we humans move out of narcissism and tribalism to an appreciation of, even a love for, others.

Yet I wonder if the Holy Spirit isn’t trying to move me/us to a deeper level of moral sensitivity, to a sense of the interconnectedness of all of life, to an awareness that God’s Spirit animates creation. What might that change in my/our moral development demand of me/us in terms of ethical behavior?
