# WORD *on* FAITH

Having Ash Wednesday and St. Valentine's Day coincide prompted me to consider the relationship between repenting and loving. As a long time member of Al-Anon, I link repenting to making "a searching and fearless moral inventory of" myself. I look at the attitudes and behaviors that enable me to live an honest and loving life—and those attitudes and behaviors that do not. With this inventory in hand, I probe deeper as I admit "to God, to myself and to another human being the exact nature of the wrongs" I have committed. With that work behind me, I ready myself to have God remove these habituated "defects of character" and I humbly ask God to do so.

That completes the internal work I must do to repent; now I need to turn to the external work by making amends to anyone my attitudes or actions have harmed—unless to do so would be injurious to that person or others. I have found this step difficult and amazing. Not only does making a direct amend usually clear the air in my relationship with that person, but it also creates a spaciousness within me. It is as if the entry leading into my heart is remodeled, expanded to create room for more people, more love.

Repenting enables loving—that is the relationship between the two. I welcome this Lenten invitation to repent, to take my inventory, to name any obstacle that blocks my ability to respond lovingly to myself, others, creation. As those obstacles break up, a wondrous spring within me flows freely—and I become more and more aware of Love, more and more willing to love.
