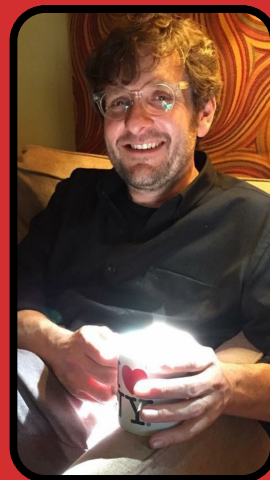
**Dave Berg**

Dave Berg is a singer/songwriter originally from Portland, OR now making his home in Nashville, TN. His songs have been recorded by a wide array of artists including Keith Urban, Bake Shelton, Carrie Underwood, Kenny Chesney, Rodney Atkins, Jewel, Jimmy Buffett, Reba McEntire and Meatloaf to name a few. He's had five number one country songs to his credit, including the most played country song of 2008, "If You're Going Through Hell" recorded by Rodney Atkins. Other hits include "Stupid Boy" by Keith Urban, "These Are My People" by Rodney Atkins, "Moments" by Emerson Drive and "What Kinda Gone" by Chris Cagle. In 2008 Berg was named Billboard's Country Songwriter of the Year, as well as ASCAP (American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers) Country Songwriter of the Year. Berg has also recorded three independent singer/songwriter records of his own, "Three Perfect Days" "Surface" and "Not Quite So Alone"

Over the last 20 years, his songs have been recorded by classic singers like George Strait, Alan Jackson, and Harry Connick, Jr. as well as today's hottest Country stars like Luke Bryan, Blake Shelton, and Lainey Wilson.

Also Raffi. Jay's professional honors include Number One songs on multiple charts, a BMI Million Air Award, and a Grammy nomination for Country Song of the Year.

Carolyn is a Canadian country music singer-songwriter. Johnson co-wrote Chely Wright's 1999 single, "Single White Female," which reached number one on the Billboard Hot Country Singles & Tracks chart in September 1999. Johnson was signed, in 2000, to record label Arista Nashville. In 2001, Johnson released her debut album Room with a View. The album's first single "Georgia" reached No. 4 on the RPM Canadian Country Singles Chart for the week of November 6, 2000. "Complicated" was a Top Ten hit on the U.S. Billboard Hot Country Singles & Tracks chart. Her next single ("I Don't Want You to Go") was also a Top Ten hit in the U.S.



**Adam Hambrick**

Adam is a country music singer and songwriter who has also written for Dan + Shay ("How Not To"), Justin Moore ("Somebody Else Will"), Eli Young Band, Lindsay Ell ("Waiting on You"), and several other musicians. He is signed to Capitol Records Nashville/Buena Vista.
